CORTEX Prize 2023

The **Cortex Prize** is a biennial award to emphasize the achievements in neuroscience. It is awarded to a **promising young scientist** in the field of neuropsychology.

The scientist has to be within 7 years from the PhD. The awardee will be recommended by their member society **Each member society can support at most one colleague.**

The Scientific Advisory Board of the FESN does the ranking of all candidates and proposes one scientist after reviewing his scientific work.

The prize is officially granted during the FESN congress 2023 in Thessaloniki. **The winner is invited to give a keynote address and the FESN congress 2023 in Thessaloniki**

He/she is also invited to **submit a review** of his/her work to the **journal 'Cortex'**. Further information

Application Procedure

- Candidates **apply by their national society** and hand in
 - an up-to-date curriculum vitae with contact details (email address and picture in jpg format).
 - 1-3 papers as pdf as an example of the scientific work
- The **national society recommends one candidate** with a letter of nomination,
- Recommendations should be sent to the FESN by **November 15th 2022**
- Winners will be informed by December 31st 2022.
